 Sneak Preview of TEKI COMETH with director Daihachi Yoshida and actor Kyozo Nagatsuka
 Audience: 110

Our second packed screening event of 2025 drew a huge Japanese press contingent and an older-skewing FCCJ audience than the first, although *Teki Cometh* went on to reach the younger generation in theaters, where it's currently enjoying a strong run. The film was newsworthy primarily because it was the first Japanese title to win the Tokyo International Film Festival Grand Prix in 19 years, as well as the Best Director Award and a Best Actor Award for veteran Kyozo Nagatsuka, playing an octogenarian widower who is grappling with something more than just cognitive decline. Nagatsuka thrilled the audience by opening the Q&A session with remarks in fluent French (he is a Sorbonne graduate). There was a rousing discussion of the ambiguous meaning of "the enemy" (*Teki* means *enemy*), about Nagatsuka's revelation during one of the film's nude scenes, and a general agreement that the sumptuous monochrome was the right choice for many reasons, including that it helped the film avoid a "foodie" label for all the yummy-looking meals that are prepared onscreen. The event received extensive print/online/TV coverage the next day.
