SCREENINGS REPORT

April 15Special Screening of A SAMURAL IN TIME with
director Junichi Yasuda, actor Makiya Yamaguchi

Audience: 90

By special arrangement with distributor Gaga, we were able to screen one of the unlikeliest success stories in Japanese film history, nearly 7 months after it first appeared in theaters (it's still playing, as well as on Amazon Prime). Completed on a minuscule budget of just 26 million yen (\$170,000), *A Samurai in Time* went from strength to strength, going from sold-out screenings in one mini-theater in Ikebukuro to its pickup by Gaga, which rolled it out to over 400 cinemas nationwide. After climbing into the Top 10 at the box office and grossing more than double most Hollywood hits in Japan, it then became the first-ever independent feature to win the Best Film Academy Award in Japan, along with a Best Editor trophy for the director. The FCCJ audience loved the backstory, but the surprising focus was on Yasuda's *other* career, as a rice farmer near Kyoto. Noting that he wouldn't have been able to continue farming the family land if the film had been a flop, he criticized the government's rice policy. "Rice farmers have a really tough time, and I'm losing ¥100,000 for every crop, rather than being allowed to sell at an equitable price," he lamented. Despite receiving ample coverage already, the Q&A guests were covered by numerous online and TV crews, as well as the print press.
